## To Reduce Risk of Injury, Don't Ride the Segway HT Through Security Systems

Security systems, such as theft detection systems at the entrances and exits to libraries and stores and metal detectors at the entrances to courthouses, in airports, and other governmental buildings, may interfere with the Segway® Human Transporter's ("Segway HT") ability to balance and may cause unexpected Segway HT behavior. Because of the wide variety of these systems currently in use, it is impossible to predict how all of these systems might affect the Segway HT. To reduce risk of injury, do not attempt to ride the Segway HT through these systems. Instead, stop and step off the Segway HT not less than five feet (1.5 meters) before the detectors and walk the Segway HT through the detectors. Do not resume riding until you are at least five feet (1.5 meters) past the detectors.

If you are in doubt about whether a building (or room) entrance or exit has such a security system, exercise caution and proceed on the assumption that it does. Do not ride the Segway HT through the entrance or exit.

Not all security systems are alike. Just because you have safely ridden through security systems in the past, don't assume that you can continue to do so. Exercise caution and walk the Segway HT through the system.
